Táng xiānsheng xiǎng hē dōngxī.

Táng first-born want-like drink east-west.

我想吃一点东西。 I would like to eat a little something.

Wǒ xiǎng chī yī diǎn dōngxī.

I want-like eat one dot east-west.

王小姐不想吃东西。 Ms. Wang would not like to eat anything.

Wáng xiǎojiě bù xiǎng chī dōngxī.

Wang little-big-sister not want-like eat east-west.

这个商店有很多东西可以买。

This store has a lot of things you can buy.

Zhè gè shāngdiàn yǒu hěn duō dōngxī kěyǐ mǎi.

This one store has very much east-west can buy.

长春的东西不是很贵。 Things in Changchun are not very expensive.

Chángchūn de dōngxī bù shì hěn guì.

Changchun-of east-west not very expensive.

我的学生学东西快。 My students learn things quickly.

Wǒ de xuésheng xué dōngxī kuài.

I-of study-born study east-west fast.

郑先生学东西快。 Mr. Zheng learns things quickly.

Zhèng xiānsheng xué dōngxī kuài.

Zhen first-born study east-west fast.
